## **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:**

The lead applicants (coordinators) must

- be legal entities (public/private bodies)
- be established in one of the eligible countries, i.e.: EU
   Member States (including overseas countries and
   territories) or non-EU country associated to the CERV
   Programme or countries which are in ongoing
   negotiations for an association agreement and where
   the agreement enters into force before grant signature
   (list of participating countries)
- be non-profit-making;

Co-applicants (if any) must be legal entities (public /private bodies) formally established in one of the eligible countries or an international organisation.

Activities must take place in any of the eligible countries.

The project can be either national or transnational.

The application may involve 1 or more organisations

The applicant must fulfil both of the following conditions:

- a) have recent proven experience of at least 3 years in implementing CSO capacity building activities;
- b) have recent proven experience in awarding and managing grants.

If the proposal is submitted by a consortium, the consortium must fulfil both above conditions.

Proposals must include both:

- Financial support to third parties (CSOs) by intermediaries
- Capacity building for CSO
